<b>BILL NO.</b>	<b>TITLE of BILL</b>	<b>ACTION</b>
<b>SENATE 1</b>	<b>DISCIPLINE FOR BULLYING OFF SCHOOL PROPERTY (Education)</b> This legislation would provide penalties for students who engage in bullying activities outside of school property.	
<b>SENATE 2</b>	<b>VOTER ID (State Government)</b> This legislation requires that all individuals that present themselves to vote at a Pennsylvania polling place must provide valid identification in order to cast a ballot.	
<b>SENATE 3</b>	<b>SEAT BELTS ON SCHOOL BUSES (Transportation)</b> This bill will require that all school buses and school vehicles must be equipped with seat belts.	
<b>SENATE 4</b>	<b>CLEAN STREAMS ACT (Environmental Resources &amp; Energy)</b> This bill will establish the Clean Streams Fund to clean up damaged rivers and streams.	
<b>SENATE 5</b>	<b>PASS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (Education)</b> This bill will establish the Pennsylvania Award for Student Success (PASS) Scholarship Program. The program provides eligible students the ability to either choose an alternative educational environment at a nonpublic school with a state-funded school voucher.	
<b>SENATE 6</b>	<b>DRUG TESTING FOR WELFARE BENEFITS (State Government)</b> This bill shall develop and implement a drug test and drug retest program for applicants and recipients of public assistance benefits through the Department of Human Services.	
<b>SENATE 7</b>	<b>BAN CELL PHONES WHILE DRIVING (Transportation)</b> This bill states the use of a hand-held cellular phone while operating a motor vehicle that is in motion upon a public roadway is prohibited.	
<b>SENATE 8</b>	<b>PFAS PREVENTION (Environmental Resources &amp; Energy)</b> This bill will prevent the use of PFAS chemicals in AstroTurf athletic fields at the high school, college and professional level.
